What is the IB Diploma Programme?

The IBDP is a challenging two-year course aimed at students aged 16-19. It leads to a qualification that is widely welcomed by the world's leading universities and employers. Students are required to choose six subjects, in addition to a core programme.



Entry requirements: Grade 4 for subjects at Standard Level (SL) and Grade 6 or 7 for subjects at Higher Level (HL).
